Assessment Success Support Ideas for Volunteer Site Contacts

Utilize school volunteers to support assessment preparations and to make assessment days special at your school. Ways volunteers can assist include:

- Recruiting volunteers to prepare and display assessment posters.
- Creating posters with slogans, such as: "DO YOUR BEST TODAY!" or "SHOW WHAT YOU KNOW."
- Preparing materials, such as refrigerator magnets with assessment dates, reminder labels, and goody bags of healthy snacks for test days.
- Putting materials and games together for Assessment Nights.
- Assisting with presentations about assessments or assessment results to the Parent Organization or Site Council.
- Organizing volunteers to get parents to write notes of encouragement to students prior to assessments.
- Inviting a group of parents to attend any assessment related school assemblies and help cheer for student success (pep rally style).
- Organizing volunteers to meet students at the door on assessment days with high-fives and encouraging words.
- Organizing volunteers to help serve water and/or healthy snacks on assessment days.
