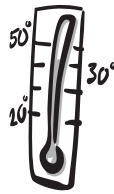

too cold to play ball ...)



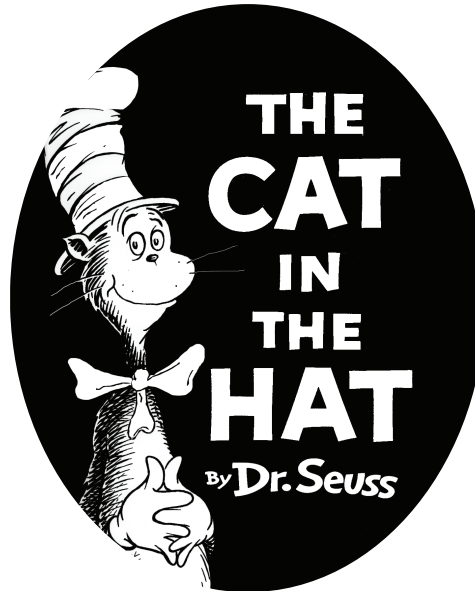
What might the thermometer look like?

What would you do on this type of day? Draw a picture.

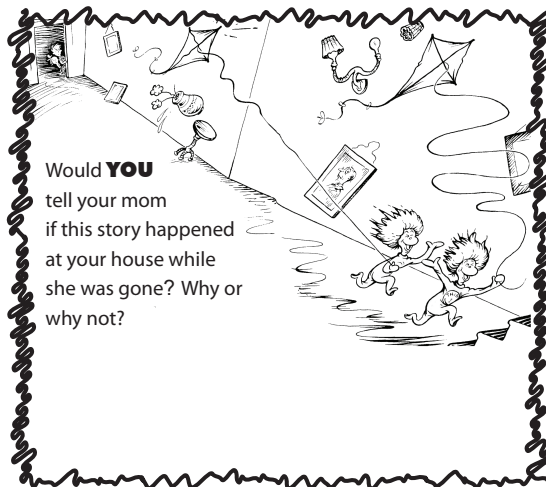
