The following are sample reading messages translated to Spanish.

- Encourage your student to read, read, read!

- Encourage your child to continuing reading at home
Aliente a su hijo(a) a seguir leyendo en casa.
- The goal this year is for each student to read one million words, which is equivalent to 25 books!

Masculine (Use for a male student. Don't forget to substitute John's name for correct boy name.)
