Connecting With Families

Porch Visit Purpose:

To develop trust and rapport with families by meeting them on "their own turf" where they feel more comfortable and empowered.

Porch Visit Goals:

- Welcome families to the school community
- Establish rapport and put family at ease
- Observe families' general home environment and focus attention on family
- Distribute information
- Communicate staff involvement and staff support
- Promote parent involvement and home support

Porch Visits Benefit All

- 1. Porch visits are a unique opportunity to establish positive communication between home and school.
- 2. Early visits show how eager teachers, principals, and school staff are to work with all families.
- 3. Porch visits increase teachers' understanding of their students by seeing them in their home environment.
- 4. Parents who are uncomfortable coming to the school may feel more at ease and be able to tell us how we can help them be involved in their children's education.
- 5. Building positive relationships with students and families leads to better academic achievement, improved attendance, improved discipline and increased parent involvement.
- 6. Home visits offer vast rewards including exposure to the richness and variety of many cultures, the hospitality extended by families, and the chance to share a brief slice of life with the families of the children we work with everyday.
