Everyday Mathematics whole group lesson with parents (**10 minutes** for introduction section and then **30 minutes** for the lesson/take home game):

- 1. If you have not done a Family Math Night this year, you will need to get the Introductory Packet and use that for the first 10 minutes
- 2. Explain that you will be doing activities that the students do on a daily basis.
- 3. Opening (get them thinking about numbers): Play Sparkle, using the number 5. Stand in a circle. Parents and students count by ones. Every time someone lands on '5' they must sit down. Play until only one person is left standing.
- 4. Core: Play Roll Again. Have a variety of organizers so that parents can see how different tools can be used the same way. Give them several minutes to play.
- 5. Reflection: 'Students, what was the same about your game boards. What was different?
